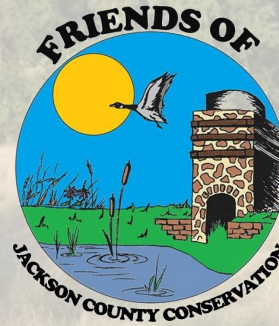

Located in eastern Maquoketa, Prairie Creek Recreation Area is a 273 acre property donated by Robert Martin in 2013 to the JCCB.



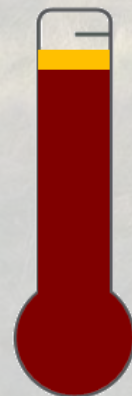
# Leave Your Legacy
